

**Clause to use when information is requested by other organisations (eg ARC) on the University's intellectual property policy and procedures**

The University requires that all staff and/or students notify the University (via its Intellectual Property and Commercialisation Management Committee [IPCMC]), of any potential IP that they develop. The IPCMC decides, in conjunction with the inventors/authors, if there is a favourable opportunity for commercialisation of the IP. The University (through the IPCMC) is then responsible for managing the commercialisation process. Ownership of Intellectual Property will remain with the University, which then develops, licences or assigns the IP appropriately. The University shares any benefits with the inventors/authors.
